

## **ECA Admission Committee University of Delhi**

### **Guidelines for Admission to Undergraduate Programs under ECA Category for the Academic Year 2021-2022**

1. The University of Delhi conducted Centralized ECA Admissions for the academic year 2021-22 on the basis of evaluation/marketing of ECA certificates only. Due to the unprecedented situation of COVID-19 pandemic and prevailing public health guidelines, trials (online/offline) were not conducted.
2. Undergraduate Admissions under ECA category will be applicable only for Merit Based programmes and not for programs where admission is based on an entrance test.
3. The allotment of Program and College to candidates under ECA shall be done in a centralized manner by the University through centralized ECA Merit List and based on preferences of Programs and Colleges indicated by the candidate on their Dashboard on the online portal. The allotment of College and Program will be based on the **rank** of the candidate in the Centralized ECA Merit List, subject to availability of ECA category/sub-category in the College and fulfilment of other eligibility criteria as described under points #4 to #7 below.
4. Not more than **15%** concession in academic merit vis-a-vis unreserved category candidates (from the last relevant cut-off OR the list after which admissions were closed for that program) may be given by the College for admission (subject to the minimum eligibility requirements of the program). The specific concession in academic merit offered to candidates by each college is listed in **Table 1**.
5. The seat matrix for various ECA categories and subcategories of each College is given in **Table 2**. Candidates are required to use this information while indicating their choice of program/college. Candidates SHOULD NOT opt for a college which does not have seats for their respective ECA category/sub-category.
6. The candidates are required to refer to the UG Bulletin of Information (BOI) [https://admission.uod.ac.in/userfiles/downloads/15092021\\_UG-Bulletin\\_compressed.pdf](https://admission.uod.ac.in/userfiles/downloads/15092021_UG-Bulletin_compressed.pdf) for eligibility criteria. Candidates must refer to Program specific eligibility criteria given in Sections 2.2-2.10 of the BOI.

7. All the declared eligible candidates for admission on the basis of ECA are required to give their preference **for all applicable Colleges and Programs [maximum forty (40) Colleges and maximum three (3) programs per College]**, on their Dashboard at the University of Delhi UG Admission Portal, based on guidelines outlined in points #4, #5 and #6 above.
8. There will be no restriction on the number of Colleges (**maximum forty (40) Colleges and maximum three (3) programs per College**) that the candidate may give preference for seeking admission on the basis of ECA. However, they are required to select only those Programs where they meet the specific eligibility criteria and for Colleges which offer seats under their specific ECA category/sub-category. The allotment of a College and Program to the candidate will be based on the options selected by them on the dashboard subject to fulfilment of program-specific eligibility criteria in confirmation with University regulations, ECA Seat Matrix of Colleges and in accordance with other admission guidelines.
9. All eligible candidates desirous of admission as per the Centralized ECA Merit list will be given **only one chance** to register their preferences for the applicable Colleges and Programs (refer to point #8 above). Once the candidate registers his/her preference no further change will be allowed. The candidates are advised to exercise their preference to the maximum permissible.
10. **The Dashboard for eligible candidates, as per Centralized ECA Merit List on the UG Admission Portal, will be open for registering their preferences for the allotment of Program and College from Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 to Friday, 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2021. All eligible candidates are informed that no further chance of registering their preferences for allotment of College and Program will be given after Friday, 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2021.**
11. Selection/Inclusion of a candidate's name in the ECA Merit List does not guarantee his/her admission in any College and Program. The allocation of College and Program to a candidate shall be subject to fulfilment of program-specific eligibility criteria, availability of the program in the College, availability of seats under the specific ECA category/sub-category in the college and the rank of the candidate in the merit list.

12. Once allocation has been done, the College and Program allotted to the candidate will be visible on his/her Dashboard. The candidates are further advised to complete their admission formalities through online mode within the stipulated time. No grievance will be entertained in case a candidate fails to apply or pay the fees (if approved by the College) within the stipulated period.
13. The candidates are advised to keep checking their Dashboard and the University Admission portal regularly for detailed Schedule and Guidelines on UG ECA Admissions 2021-2022.
14. A Second Centralized ECA Admission List (if required) may be declared after the First Centralized ECA Admission List, on the basis of previously registered preferences (i.e. 10<sup>th</sup> November to 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2021) by the applicants for allotment of Colleges and Programs. **Candidates who have been allotted a specific College and Program in the First Centralized ECA Admission List will not be considered in the Second Centralized ECA Admission List.**
15. All admissions under ECA Category are provisional subject to forensic examination/verification of the originals of all the uploaded ECA certificates. A candidate submitting false/fake certificates for seeking admission on the basis of ECA shall be debarred from admission to any College for three years. Such admissions will be cancelled and strict legal action will be taken against the erring candidates.
