University of Delhi invites applications for admission to ITEP-2023

The University of Delhi, a premier institution of higher education, invites applications from interested candidates to its Integrated Teacher Education Programme-ITEP.

As envisaged in the National Education Policy 2020, ITEP is a four-year degree programme exemplifying the process of developing a multidisciplinary approach to Teacher Education in higher education. The programme is of four-year duration with credits distributed across eight semesters of study. It is a dual-major bachelor's degree programme, with one major in Education and the other in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary branch of knowledge.

This year, the programme is being offered in two premier women colleges, Mata Sundari College, and Shyama Prasad Mukherjee College. The colleges are further offering stage-specific specializations in B.A. B. Ed. (Middle) and B.A. B. Ed. (Secondary).

Women candidates who are interested in taking admission in ITEP must have appeared in the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2023 conducted by NTA. For applying to University of Delhi, the candidate must register at <http://itep.uod.ac.in> using her NCET-2023 Application Number. Last date for registration is **October 20, 2023**.
