- Mark-sheet and Certificate class 10th onwards, and any other testimonials for Academic Qualifications.
- Graduation Marksheet & other relevant documents
- Post Graduation Marksheet & other relevant documents
- Candidates are required to bring 3 hard copies of the proposal/synopsis submitted online for the interview.
- UGC/CSIR NET with JRF certificate/ other notified fellowships (if applicable)

PLEASE NOTE:

- Candidates should ensure that they are meeting the minimum eligibility for admission to Ph.D. in Psychology, as mentioned below:
- "55 % Marks in Master's Degree (Psychology/Applied Psychology/Behavioural & Cognitive Sciences/Human Development and Family Studies) from a recognized University with 5% relaxation for OBC/SC/ST and Persons with disability".
- If any candidate does not meet the minimum eligibility criteria, they can be denied to appear in the interview.
- Each candidate appearing for the offline interview will be allotted 5-6 minutes for PPT presentation with a maximum of 5 slides (inclusive of title slide). The presentation will be followed by the interview by the panel members.
- In case the applicant gets selected on the basis of the credentials furnished by him/her, which upon scrutiny are found to be incorrect/inadmissible/falsified, his/her candidature shall be cancelled at any stage of admission/at any time during Ph.D.
- No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview
