Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB) has been silently contributing towards empowerment of women through education since 1944. At that time, the idea was to provide a platform to girl students to take examinations with special coaching without attending regular classes. Over the years, this gave shape to an institution which provided for the needs of educating girls who were in a disadvantageous position to attend regular classes in colleges. NCWEB is in a unique position to endow those who have the potential to change and give thrust to socioeconomic development in the society through education. NCWEB is a constituent part of University of Delhi.

This institution has an arrangement where the girl students attend classes during Saturday / Sunday and academic breaks across the twenty-six centres being run in the constituent colleges of University of Delhi for undergraduate courses and for postgraduate courses, at the NCWEB Centre respectively. These centres provide for library and other facilities besides utilizing the existing resources and infrastructure of the colleges. The Postgraduate Centre has a library located in the Arts Faculty Building, University of Delhi. The Board also gives financial aid and book loan facility to the needy and desirous students. At present, nearly 33,000 girl students are studying under the institution. Many among those who have studied in this institution have not only stood on their own but have also been pillars of strength to their families. This institution is dedicated to the cause of nation building by empowering those who play a pivotal role in molding the society through education.

Any change so made shall be updated on the Board's website. • Registration for Admission to Undergraduate courses in NCWEB will be through UG Online Registration process by University of Delhi. And it is mandatory for all the candidates to register & apply through the advertised admission link. A separate admission form is provided by University of Delhi. • Minimum Eligibility Criteria as well as other terms and conditions prescribed by the University of Delhi for UG courses are applicable for NCWEB admission also. • Only women candidates residing in NCT Delhi will be eligible for admission to UG courses of NCWEB, University of Delhi. Residence proof in the name of the candidate will be required at the time of the admission. It can be a valid Aadhaar Card, Voter Identity Card, Passport, Driving License or Ration Card (with the name of the candidate). • OBC-NCL/EWS certificate should be issued on or after 1st April, 2025 in the name of the candidate. • The candidates are advised to take admission in the NCWEB Centre near their residence. After taking admission in a NCWEB Centre, change of Centre or admission transfer to any other NCWEB Centre is not allowed under any circumstances. • All admissions are provisional till confirmed by the University. Moreover, at the time of Admission, an undertaking has to be given by the candidate for anti-ragging and maintaining minimum 67% attendance in each session. • The last date given by University/ Centre / related offices will be non-negotiable. • An orientation programme for the NCWEB students at their respective UG Teaching Centre will be held after the completion of the admission process. * The course fees for B.A. (Prog.) & B.Com is subject to revision by the Competent Authority of the University of Delhi. **Registration for admission on the link:** https://ncwebadmission.uod.ac.in

2. List of Documents Required

I. Class X Certificate: (Marksheet or certificate) indicating date of birth and Parents' names (The name of applicant claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS/CW/KM must match with the names that appear on the corresponding reservation certificates; similarly, their parents' names must match in all sets of the certificates).



II. Class XII Marksheet of a recognized Board.

III. SC/ST Certificates: The following are empowered to issue the requisite SC/ST certificate: (a) District Magistrate/ Additional District Magistrate/ Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/ Addl. Deputy Commissioner/ Deputy Collector/ 1st class Stipendiary Magistrate/ City Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Com- missioner. (b) Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Addl. Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate. (c) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.(d) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the Applicant and/ or his family normally resides. (e) Administrator/ Secretary to the Administrator/ Development Officer (Lakshadweep Islands). The applicant must note that the SC/ ST Certificate from any other person/ authority shall not be accepted in any case. If the applicant happens to belong to SC or ST, applicant's caste/ tribe must be listed in the appropriate Govt. of India Schedule. The Caste Certificate should clearly state: (a) Name of his/ her caste/ tribe (b) whether applicant belongs to SC or ST (c) District and the State or Union Territory of applicant's usual place of residence, and (d) the appropriate Govt. of India Schedule under which his/ her caste/





tribe is approved as SC or ST. If the applicant does not have their SC or ST caste/ tribe certificate at the time of registration/ applying, they may upload the acknowledgement slip of the SC or ST caste/tribe certificate application. However, at the time of admission, the applicant will have to produce the valid original SC or ST caste/tribe certificate.

- IV. OBC, Non-Creamy Layer, Central List: The OBC applicants who belong to the "Non-Creamy Layer" and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs only, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC certificate in respect of "Non-creamy layer" status of the applicants as per DOPT Office Memorandum No. 36036 /2/2013- Estt. (Res- I) dated 31 March 2016). The validity of the non-creamy layer certificate shall be for the financial year 2025-2026, issued on or after 1st April, 2025.
- V. EWS: As per the University of Delhi notifications (Reference No. Aca. I / Reservation of EWSs / 2019 / 63 Dated 28th March 2019 and Reference No. Aca. I / Reservation of EWSs / 2019 / 101 Dated 15th May 2019), for the reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) Category, the University Departments / Centres / Colleges have reserved seats for admission for the same in the Academic Year 2025-26. The eligibility of such applicants will be decided on the basis of fulfilling criteria prescribed in the above notifications, and subject to submission of documents, issued by the competent authority, in the format provided in Appendix V of BOI. The validity of the Income Certificate shall be for the financial year 2025-26, issued on or after 1st April, 2025.
- VI. **PwBD:** As per the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, not less than five percent (5%) seats are reserved for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities. Person with benchmark disability means a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability where the specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with a disability where the specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the competent authority.
- VII. Proof of residence in NCT of Delhi (Aadhar Card / Voter ID / Passport /Driving License / Ration Card with the name of the candidate)

Undergraduate Merit-Based Admission Process

Step I: Registration on the UG portal

The candidates must use **NCWEB Delhi University UG Admissions portal** to create their personal username and password, fill in their registration form, choose their programs of interest, and upload the required documents. The candidates must exercise extreme care in filling up their form. Much of the information entered by the candidates into the form will not be allowed to be edited and corrected after submission of the form.

- All the candidates seeking admission to the Undergraduate (UG) programs are required to register online link <u>https://ncwebadmission.uod.ac.in</u> Any first-time user, in order to access NCWEB Delhi University UG Admissions portal, need to register on the portal with a valid e-mail ID (e-mail ID once registered on Portal can't be used for any other registration for admission in DU).
- 2. Candidates who do not have a valid e-mail ID must create an e-mail ID before proceeding.
- 3. The candidates need to keep this e-mail ID handy because it will be required to access his /her account on the portal as well as for all future correspondence throughout the admission process and subsequent to admission process also. (Keep your email Id & password save and secured)
- 4. The default settings allow all candidates to register for both the programs of NCWEB.
- 5. The candidates will be eligible to take admission in all the colleges and programs provided they satisfy the cut-off of the colleges and the eligibility for the selected programs.
- 6. Utmost care must be exercised in uploading the documents. Candidates will need scanned copies of the certificates as mentioned below for registration and admission.
 - (a) Class X certificate
 - (b) Class XII certificate
 - (c) Relevant reservation certificate issued by competent issuing authority
 - (d) Photo Identity Card: (Aadhaar Card, Driving License, PAN Card, Voter Identity Card, Passport
 - or any government Identity proof)
 - (e) Address proof of NCT Delhi: Aadhaar Card, Driving License, Voter Identity Card, Passport issued in the name of the candidate or Ration Card (with the name of the candidate)
- 7. Candidates will be responsible for all the information they upload, including the copies of certificates. The candidates will be responsible for the quality and authenticity of the uploaded files. The candidates will be able to see the preview of their form and the uploaded documents. The candidates are advised to take all care to avoid rejection on this basis during the admission process.

The candidates must remember/keep a record of her phone number used, user Id and password during registration.

Step II: Payment of the registration fees

The registration form will be deemed submitted only after realization of the relevant registration fee. This fee must be paid only through the link provided through the candidate's Dashboard. There is no method available to candidates other than this online link generated for payment of the registration fee. When the candidate has successfully submitted the registration fee online, they are advised to keep records of the payment's transaction ID, Credit Card/ Debit card/ Net banking details and date of transaction as proof for future reference. Further, the candidates are advised to complete the process well before the deadline in order to avoid any last-minute glitches.

4. Minimum Eligibility Criteria for UG Courses

Qualifying examinations for the purpose of admission to the first year of Merit based undergraduate programs offered by the University of Delhi shall be Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (Class XII) of the Central Board of Secondary Education or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto. The candidates seeking admission to these undergraduate programs offered by the University should have passed the qualifying examination obtaining minimum marks as specified for each of the programs.

• Merit shall be determined based on one language (from list A) and the three best elective subjects as per the following rules laid down by the University of Delhi.

B.A. Prog. (Discipline Subject Combination based Admission)	 An aggregate of 40% marks in the qualifying examination. The merit shall be determined on the basis of one language (core/elective/functional) and three best academic/elective subjects as specified in List A and List B above may be chosen. One non-listed subject (besides the elective subjects in Lists A and B) can be included in the calculation of 'Best Four' without any deduction. If more than one non-listed subject is included for calculation of 'Best Four', a deduction of 2.5% each in 'Best Four' may be levied.
B. Com.	 An aggregate of 40% marks in the qualifying examination. Selection shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in qualifying examination including one language and the three best subjects, as per the following: An aggregate of 40% or more in English/Hindi and a combination of the best three from among the following subjects: Mathematics, Accountancy, Economics and Business Studies/Commerce. Inclusion of any subject from List B other than the mentioned above in the combination of the best three will lead to a deduction of 1% per subject on the aggregate. Inclusion of any subject other than those in Lists A and B in the combination of best three will lead to a deduction of 2.5% per subject on the aggregate of the Best Four.

7. Guidelines for the Students

- For the names and locations of various Teaching Centers and courses offered by the NCWEB, please check the University / Board website: www.du.ac.in or http://ncweb.du.ac.in/web/
- After enrolment with the Board, all correspondence is to be addressed to the Director/Dy Director, NCWEB through the Teacher-in-Charge of the Centre.
- All correspondence must bear the Enrolment No. of the candidate, along with her contact details, like phone, e-mail and postal address. In case there is any change in her residential address, the candidates should write to the Director/ Asst. / Deputy Director/Registrar, NCWEB through the Teaching Centre for necessary changes in office records.





- The candidates must ensure that they have filled in the Examination Form at their respective Teaching Centre/ Board's Office, in time without which they will not be permitted to appear in the University Examination.
- The candidates are advised to preserve the Admission Fee receipt and Acknowledgement of the Examination Form. While submitting the Examination Form, the students are advised to bring with them, their Identity Card and Marks Statement of the last University Exam for ready reference.
- The students must note that it will be entirely their responsibility to personally get in touch with the teaching college centre for payment of Examination Fee/Annual Fee and collection of Admission Ticket (Roll Number)/Date sheet/Marks Statement/Degree Certificate etc. or for any information they require.
- The Examination for the B.A. (Prog.) / B.Com. are held as per schedule fixed by the Dean (Examination), University of Delhi.
- A student has to pay her fee and fill out the Examination Form within due date based on first declared result. In case of Re-evaluation/Re-checking, as soon as the result is declared, the students who wish to apply for revaluation/rechecking, have to fill the form and pay the requisite fee and submit this to the Examination Branch.
- The candidate enrolled for B.A. Programme / B.Com. will be required to complete the course within five years of their first enrolment.
- Failed students are required to deposit their fee as per the university rules announced from time to time.

*Subject to change as per the implementation of National Education Policy (NEP).

8. Attendance

- Students must attend classes from the first day of teaching. Attendance will be counted from the first day irrespective of the date when result is announced.
- Attendance in classes is compulsory. Students must have a minimum attendance of 67% otherwise they may not be given Admission Ticket (Roll No.) for the examination.
- Those students who are employed will not be allowed any concession in attendance.
- Students should be very careful about their attendance. If their name is not in the teacher's register, they should report to the Teacher-in-Charge or the First Assistant at the centre and get their name added through a written statement from office of the Centre.
- Students while taking part in the extracurricular activities should take care that they have to have good attendance, and maximum 6% attendance will be given for these activities.
- Students suffering from any sickness should keep the medical certificates along with the prescription with them and bring it to the teaching centre when asked to do so.





- All failed students of the First and Second year should contact the Board for readmission immediately after the declaration of their result i.e., within 40 days of the declaration of their result. After that no request for admission will be entertained.
- Students who have applied for revaluation also have to attend the classes based on declared result till such time that the revaluation result is declared.

9. Financial Aid / Book Loan for the Students

The Board provides Financial Aid of Rs. 3000/- to the needy and deserving students. Textbooks on each subject will also be made available to these students for the full session from the Book Bank. The deserving students should apply for the financial aid immediately after admission, on the Application Form available on the NCWEB website <u>www.ncweb.du.ac.in</u>. The duly filled form must be submitted to the Teacher-in-Charge of the Centre. Last date for submitting application for Financial Aid will be notified to the Centers.

10. DTC Bus Pass Facility

The students of the Non-Collegiate Board are entitled to avail the student concessional ordinary all route bus pass facility per month of the DTC. The forms for the same will be verified by the Teachers-in-charge of the respective Teaching Centers.

12. Compulsory Test in Hindi

If candidates enrolled for B.A./B. Com. Examination do not have Hindi as a subject, then they have to pass the Compulsory Test in Hindi, prescribed by the University of Delhi in order to be eligible for award of the Degree. The test is held in September in accordance with Ordinance V2A of the University.

Such candidates may be exempted from this test if they apply the the March every year to Director/Asstt./Deputy Registrar, Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board enclosing documentary proof of having passed one of the following examinations in Hindi:





- (a) Qualifying or Admission Examination conducted by the University of Delhi.
- (b) The Higher Education Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.
- (c) The Intermediate Examination of an Indian University.
- (d) Any other Examination recognized as equivalent to (a), (b) and(c) above.
- (e) The Oriental Titles or Diploma Examination of the Indian University incorporated by any law of the time being in force.
- (f) The Matriculation Examination or the Higher or Lower Hindi Examination included in the syllabus for the Cambridge Senior Certificate Examination, or an examination recognized as equivalent to the Matriculation Examination.
- (g) (i) The Hindi Examination prescribed for science group students at the end of IX class of the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

(ii)The test Elementary Hindi (Compulsory) conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi since November 1953 for their High School/Higher Secondary and Higher Secondary Technical Examination.

Note: Candidate appearing in the Compulsory Test in Hindi are required to fill out a separate application form obtainable from the office.
