The hard copies of the same must be submitted to the Office of the Centre for Hindu Studies, Arts Faculty Building, Main Campus, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007 latest by 05.5.2026, 2.00 pm.

Please note that if any selected candidate fails to complete the admission formalities as detailed above, the offer of admission to him/her will automatically stand cancelled without further notice and no representation regarding the same will be entertained by the Centre. Seats vacated in such cases will be offered to the applicants in the waiting list in order of merit.

In case any discrepancy is found in respect of eligibility conditions and/or documents at the time of verification and/or at any later stage, the admission of such candidate/s will be summarily cancelled, and the Centre will not be responsible for this in any respect.

It may also be noted that the PhD Programme of the Centre for Hindu Studies, University of Delhi is a Regular Programme and Course work is mandatory as per the guidelines of the University.
