- 1. Candidates should satisfy that they are meeting the minimum eligibility for admission to Ph.D. in Psychology, which is mentioned below:
- "55 % Marks in Master's Degree (Psychology/Applied Psychology/Behavioural & Cognitive Sciences/Human Development and Family Studies) from a recognized University with 5% relaxation for OBC/SC/ST and Persons with disability".
- 2. If any candidate does not meet the minimum eligibility criteria, they can be denied to appear in the interview.
- 3. The result of the candidates who have applied for Ph.D. Programme and appeared for DUET 2022 is already declared by the NTA and is available on the University website. As per qualifying criteria (50 % for Unreserved and 45% for Reserved Category), rank wise merit list is uploaded on the University website.
- 4. For candidates who had applied under M.Phil., UGC-NET and JRF category but also appeared in the entrance examination are required to appear for the interview.
- 5. Candidates should bring copy of Online Registration Form, Admit Card, Cast/Category Certificate, Mark-sheet and Certificate class 10th onwards, and any other testimonials for Academic Qualifications. Candidates are required to bring 3 hard copies of the proposal/synopsis submitted online for the interview.
- 6. Each candidate appearing for the offline interview will be allotted 10 minutes for PPT presentation with a maximum of 6 slides (inclusive of title slide). The presentation will be followed by the interaction with the panel members.
- 7. In case the applicant gets selected on the basis of the credentials furnished by him/her, which upon scrutiny are found to be incorrect/inadmissible/falsified, his/her candidature shall be cancelled at any stage of admission/at any time during Ph.D.
- 8. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.
